## DOMAINS ASSESSED



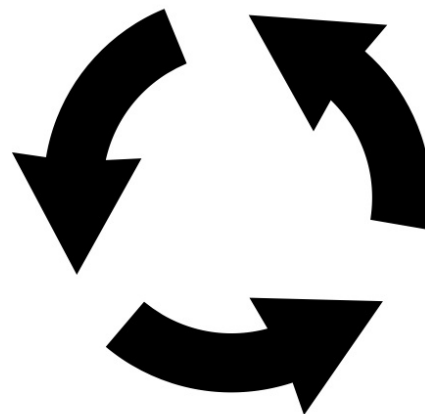
Over 100 Demographic, Static, & Dynamic Variables Measured
